11	The Oregon-Idaho Annual Conference wishes to submit to the 2012 Jurisdictional Conference
12	the following resolution:

14	The Sense of the Western Jurisdiction of the United Methodist Church, Paragraph 304.3
15	
16	Whereas the Constitution of The United Methodist Church reserves to the clergy members of
17	each Annual Conference the exclusive right to vote "on all matters relating to the character and
18	conference relations of its clergy members," [The Constitution, ¶33, 2008 Book of Discipline, p.
19	31];
20	And whomen The United Methodist Church week to the clear, week one of each Turisdistion
21 22	And whereas The United Methodist Church reserves to the clergy members of each Jurisdiction the exclusive right to sit on a trial court if a bishop from that jurisdiction is charged and tried fo
23	a violation of a disciplinary provision [¶2712, 2008 Book of Discipline, p. 773];
23 24	a violation of a disciplinary provision [\frac{1}{2}/12, 2006 book of Discipline, p. 7/3],
25	And whereas The Book of Discipline establishes among the laws of the Church that " self-
26	avowed practicing homosexuals are not to be certified as candidates, ordained as ministers, or
27	appointed to serve in The United Methodist Church" [2008 Book of Discipline, ¶ 304.3, p. 206];
28	appointed to serve in the officed Flethodist charen [2000 book of biscipline, 50 h.5, pt 200],
29	And whereas the Western Jurisdiction has adopted resolutions and statements that are
30	specifically welcoming of people regardless of sexual orientation or gender identity;
31	opening of people regularies of social orientation of gentuck recitation,
32	Be it hereby resolved that the sense of the Western Jurisdiction is that if any bishop of the
33	Western Jurisdiction be charged with ordaining or appointing a self-avowed practicing
34	homosexual, and after due Disciplinary process is tried and convicted of such an offense, that
35	an appropriate penalty to assign would be the suspension of said convicted bishop from the
36	exercise of episcopal office [2008 Book of Discipline, ¶2712.6, p. 774] for a period of 24
37	consecutive hours.
