Prayer Helps for the Vital Congregations Project—V.C.P. ...a response to A Call to Action...

In 2011 each church is being asked to develop a *Vital Congregations Project Congregational Ministry Plan* to be presented at Charge Conference. Many leaders will use the *V.C.P.* process as an opportunity for the Church to become transformed into a greater likeness of Christ.

With the goal of transforming the Church in mind, *Prayer Helps* is an invitation to involve the whole congregation in prayer as an integral part of the process. You will find prayers the committees tasked with specific questions can use when they meet as well as prayers for the worshipping community to use in the beginning and end of the process. Pages 7 & 8 are for you to use after the Congregational Ministry Plan is written and approved at your Charge Conference. After all, the purpose of V.C.P. isn't simply to approve a plan for ministry, it is to become vital congregation while doing the Ministry Plan.

The United Methodist Church is changing – often without specific awareness or intention. This process can help the church you serve to be about change - intentionally. You are invited to take the *V.C.P.* process and these *Prayer Helps* to the heart of your church. *Prayer Helps* are simply what the name implies – helps. Use them as your context requires and the Spirit leads.

May the Holy Spirit move powerfully in you and the church that you serve.

Prayer Helps

A. Beginning – Praying for the Intention of the Congregational Ministry Plan and the people who will lead the process....

(Write your own prayers: Lay out purpose; be open ended; ask the Holy Spirit to fill up those doing the work and guide the whole process; acknowledge difficult questions; pray for transformation of the church into a greater likeness of Christ.)

These prayers printed in *Prayer*Helps can be used as a starting point for your own prayers or used as is.....

The following is a Responsive Prayer suitable for printing in bulletins. You might combine it with a pastoral prayer....

New every morning is your love great God of light.

We know your love in each sun rise...each new beginning.

Many church leaders have discovered that it is easier to develop a vision plan than it is to implement it. Many have anticipated the results of focusing the church's energy in a coherent fashion only to discover that the old wine skins are difficult to discard. Too often church leaders have been through visioning processes that led to papers filed away rather than behavior changes. Will that be true for your church's *VCP Congregational Ministry Plan...* or will the plan lead to new wine being poured into new wine skins?

Much effort and much prayer is needed for a church to follow through with its SMART GOALS and hold itself accountable for what the Holy Spirit is asking of it in the *Congregational Ministry Plan*. You may already know how best to keep the plan and its aspects before your congregation. In case you don't the *Prayer Helps for the Journey* is for you to use as you plan how you will lead your church in the journey of following Jesus in this day and time. *Prayer Helps for the Journey* is specifically for the time after the Charge Conference in which the Congregational Ministry Plan is adopted.

May the Holy Spirit move powerfully in you and the church that you serve.

Prayer Helps

Fulfilling the Congregational Ministry Plan requires keeping the SMART ACTIONS and other aspects of the Plan before the church leadership and worshipping community. We will need to find ways to hold ourselves accountable for what we say we do....

A Way to Go Forward with Accountability:

Develop a Quarterly Report including data, analysis and prayer; and deliver it to both:

- Church Administrative Board or Council
- Sunday Morning Worship

Each quarter summarize one aspect of the Congregational Ministry Plan and present in both venues. This will mean that in one year four aspects of the plan will be reported. Report data and implications/conclusions of what the data demonstrates.

Each time conclude the presentation with prayer. A suggested order with prayers is printed on the next page. Use this as your context requires and the Spirit leads.

D. Going Forward...

A suggested order with prayers for receiving a quarterly report of one aspect of the Congregational Ministry Plan in worship and in the Church Administrative Board or Council.
