Distinctively Wesleyan Missions for the 21st Century - Fall Seminar

A seminar on Missions will be held on October 31st and November 1st, 2014 on the campus of Evangelical Seminary in Myerstown, PA. The speaker will be Dr. Timothy C. Tennent, president of Asbury Theological Seminary. The seminar focus will be on developing and supporting distinctively Wesleyan missions for the 21st century. Dr. Tennent will explore the history of missions and the current global opportunities. He will give guidance on developing of a mission strategy for your local church. Dr. Tennent has worked extensively on the mission field in India and has written several books on world missions. He is one of the foremost United Methodist experts on the topic.
